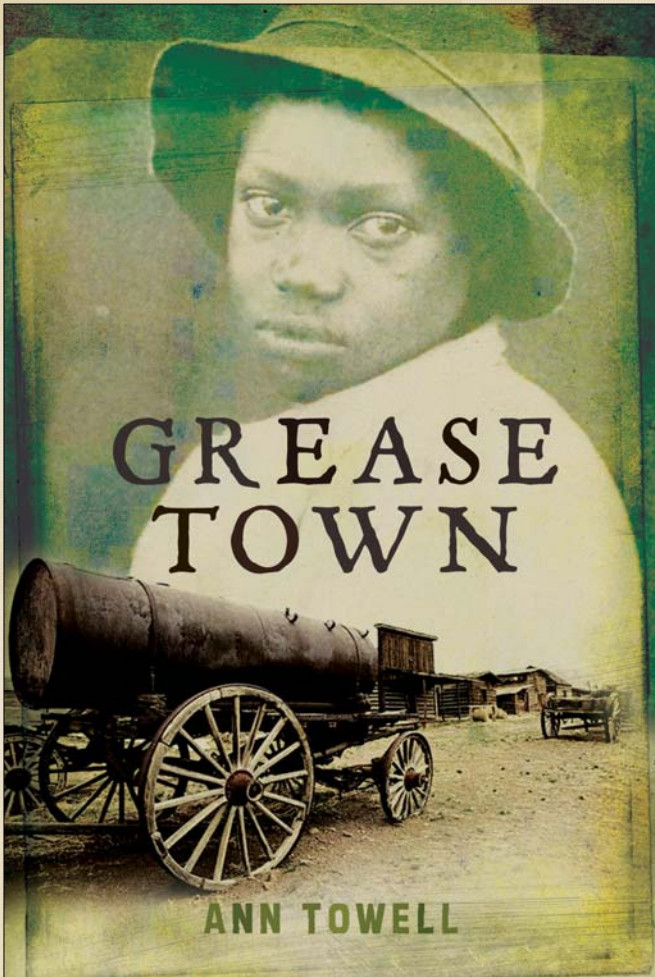


Please join **Ann Towell** in celebrating the launch of her newest novel, ***Grease Town***
