This popular event showcases the talents of craftspeople from across Southwestern Ontario and provides the perfect opportunity to pick up one-of-a-kind gifts and decorations from a variety of craft vendors.

Shoppers can take advantage of this great opportunity to pick up unique hand-made gifts at excellent prices. Vendors will be at both the Lambton Heritage Museum and the Thedford-Bosanquet Community Centre, filling four buildings, and with 25 more set up under the shade of the mature oak forest. Open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, the event is expected to attract over 5000 people. One admission allows access to all craft sale locations.

Offering work that is both functional and decorative, vendors showcase a wide range of media including pottery, ceramics, country decorating accessories, jewelry, clothing & accessories, folk art, quilting and fused glass. There is also an assortment of baked goods, and gourmet food products to take home. Choose one-of-a-kind gifts for everyone on your shopping list.
